- Launch of Club R2GS Belgium in at the end of October 2014 (50 participants)
- Half-day workshop on 14 November 2014 in Rome co-organized by CERT Nationale Italia, ISCOM, Cloud Security Alliance Italy Chapter and Club R2GS Italy, with Gerard Gaudin's participation as special guest
- In the framework of the CSP Innovation Forum co-organized by the EU Commission in April 2015, presentation of Club R2GS and ETSI ISI directions in a special session on « Cybersecurity Standards »

- Since a complementary approach and positioning is emerging between the Club R2GS network (whole Cyberdefense balancing top-down and bottom-up approaches with strong emphasis on SOCs) and the CERT/FIRST community (very technical), these respective positions have been displayed and featured at the FIC 2015 forum in Lille France (4.000 participants) during a half-day through a workshop presenting their respective visions (all Club R2GS chapters chairs or reps invited to present and/or answer to attendance's questions)
