

## CSA CHAPTER CODE OF ETHICS

The primary goal of a CSA Chapter is to serve the Cloud Security Alliance (CSA) as an outreach for research, education and training, and as an opportunity to increase cloud security awareness in the local community. To achieve this goal, members of CSA Chapters must reflect the highest standards of ethical conduct. Therefore, CSA has established the following Code of Ethics and requires its observance as a prerequisite for continued membership and affiliation with CSA and the chapter.

As a CSA chapter member, chapter leader, and/or applicant for membership, I have in the past and will in the future:

- Perform all professional activities and duties in accordance with all applicable laws and the highest ethical principles;
- Promote CSA cloud security best practices and standards;
- Maintain appropriate confidentiality of proprietary or otherwise sensitive information encountered in the course of chapter activities;
- Discharge chapter responsibilities with diligence and honesty;
- Not share member contact information or otherwise use for purposes that conflict with CSA and its mission, without express written consent of CSA;
- Refrain from any activities which might constitute a conflict of interest or otherwise damage the reputation of or is detrimental to employers, the information security profession, or CSA; and
- Not intentionally injure or impugn the professional reputation or practice of colleagues, clients, or employers.
